



Safety at Brier Elementary

At **Brier Elementary**, keeping students safe is our number one concern. We work very hard to make sure your student(s) is/are safe on campus. Our staff monitors the bus zone, walkways, and parent drop-off and pick-up areas every morning and afternoon. Student and adult safety patrols are on duty to make sure your student(s) is/are safely across the busy streets around our school. You will also see our safety patrol members monitoring the crosswalks in our driveway.

When you drive in a school zone, please follow these Washington State Laws.

- Obey all school-zone safety laws
- Drive **20 mph** when in the designated school zone
- Make a complete stop at all stop signs/lights
- Adhere to the school safety patrollers on duty
- Do not allow your vehicle to enter a crosswalk when pedestrians or school safety patrollers are occupying the crosswalk

When you enter the Brier Elementary driveway and parking lot, please...

- Obey the **10 mph** speed limit
- Keep your child(ren) buckled up until you come to a full stop
- Only pick-up and drop-off your child(ren) at the designated pick-up and drop-off area
- Do not park and get out of your vehicle in the drop-off and pick-up area
- Have your child(ren) exit your vehicle on the right side onto the sidewalk

If you park your vehicle in the visitor parking lot, please use the crosswalk near the gym and obey the safety patrol members on duty.

If your child(ren) will be walking or biking to school, please review all pedestrian safety rules. If your child(ren) would like to bike to school, please make sure that he or she has completed the bike safety form.
