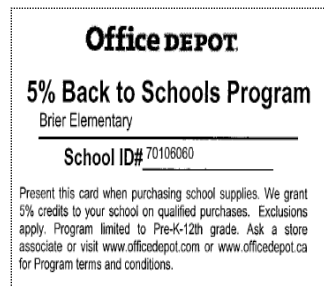

Important things to note:

No pencil boxes, please. They will be returned.

Consider the soft lunch packs instead of plastic lunch boxes that come with a thermos.

Please do not send a thermos - they leak!

Soft packs often come with an ice pack that will keep a small plastic bottle filled with your child's favorite drink cool throughout the day.

Please do not send pouch Capri-Sun type drinks unless your child can open them without help. Trying to help a classroom full of kindergarten students stick the straw into that little hole is, to say the least, amusing!
